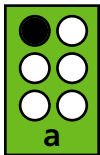

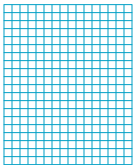

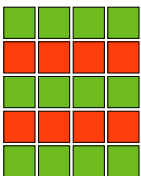
1. Find the letters of your name in Braille and write it.

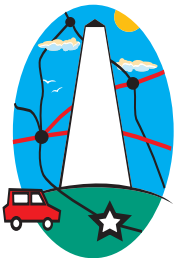
2. Print a free piece of graph paper to create a graph of student eye colors in your classroom. Make your grid one centimeter.

3. Create a quilt pattern for a class quilt. Print to add to the Quilt Bulletin Board in your classroom.

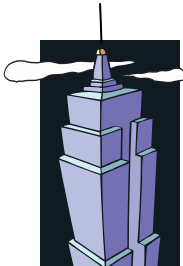
